

DRUG TESTING INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

ASAP, the Adolescent Substance Abuse Program, conducts random and for-cause urine drug testing, when judged necessary, with all youth in treatment in the ASAP Program.

But be advised urine drug testing has limitations. Urine drug testing is not perfect. Not every youth will be “caught” by use of urine drug testing. Not all drugs are commonly tested for, some are very difficult to detect, many drugs can be masked, and many young people attempt to use a variety of techniques to hide their continuing use.

Also of concern is the simple fact that more and more drugs now do not stay in the body long enough for us to have a chance to “catch” youth who are using addictive substances when they only come in for outpatient treatment at ASAP three evenings per week.

For these reasons we now advocate that parents conduct their own urine drug testing with their son/daughter, beginning immediately. Everyone living in your home must abide by your rules—and one of the rules has to be “No Addictive Substance Use.”
