

LOOKING FOR DETOX SERVICES ??

ASAP is an Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) only. ASAP does not provide any form of detox service.

However, we are sometimes asked where inpatient or outpatient detox services can be found.

(NOTE: Detox must be completed prior to the time treatment is begun at ASAP. If necessary ASAP will require families to have their youth see their physician or nurse practitioner to verify that detoxification has been completed so that IOP treatment at ASAP can safely be initiated. Only when it is verified that detox- from any drug – is complete and is therefore no longer necessary can IOP treatment in the ASAP Program begin.)

If you are seeking a detox service and have private health insurance, you may wish to start by contacting your insurance company to inquire about an appropriate provider. Some insurance companies also have an online search service on their website.

The most common question we get regarding detox is for detox from opiate addiction, which is why we have included the buprenorphine (Suboxone and Subutex) locator service. Most callers are looking for detox from opiate addiction with Suboxone or Subutex medications. Most physicians who can prescribe Suboxone or Subutex for opiate addiction also treat other forms of addiction (e.g. cocaine).
